Dementia Navigation:

Our Dementia Navigation team walks alongside families throughout the entire dementia journey, meeting their individual needs as the disease progresses. Our Navigators assist with:



- Personalized Recommendations
- Online and Phone consultations
- Information
- Referrals
- Educational Materials
- Support groups

Education:

Dementia Alliance of North Carolina provides education and training for family and professional caregivers through in-person and virtual workshops and conferences. Caregivers attending our educational programs tell us their stress levels are lower, they feel more empowered and knowledgeable about caring for their loved one, and they feel an increased sense of community by connecting with others on the same journey. Types of educational opportunities include:

- Community workshops & conferences
- Continuing education for professional caregivers

- Crisis Intervention Training (CIT) for law enforcement & first responders
- Support group facilitator training



Dementia Caregiver Assistance Program:

This program is designed to help families throughout the state receive a one-time financial assistance grant during a time of need, allowing caregivers temporary relief (respite) or resources for their caregiving journey.



Music & Memory at Home:

An evidence-based program helping people living with dementia find renewed joy and connection to life through musical favorites. Each Music and Memory Kit includes:

- Digital music player
- Headphones
- Speaker
- Personalized playlist based directly on the person's preferences



Research:
