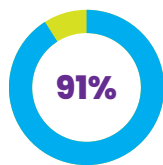
2023-2024 IMPACT REPORT

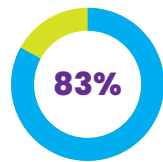

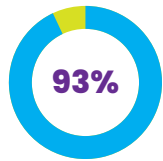
