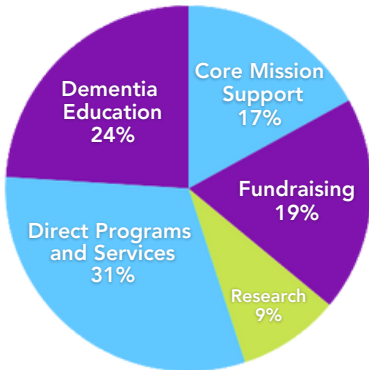

\$300,000 Research Grant Awarded

In a new partnership with BrightFocus Foundation and with support from Guardian Angel Thrift, Dementia Alliance of NC is co-funding a \$300,000, three-year research grant at UNC–Chapel Hill. Led by Dr. Todd Cohen, the study explores how strengthening a protective brain protein could reduce Alzheimer's pathology and lead to future therapies.

All funds raised remain in North Carolina.
